**PRE-REGISTRATION** – begins **August 23, 2010**, for **NEW STUDENTS, TRANSFERS** or students that have not registered. For more information call the Board Office at (403)527-2292.

### PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAMMING – ENGLISH & FRENCH

**COMMUNITY BASED & \*DESIGNATED SITE** - Children must meet specified age and eligibility requirements (**3 years of age as of September 01, 2010**). To register and for more information please contact the school directly. For children with special learning needs please contact Student Services at 403-502-8354. **Pre-School begins August 30, 2010. Contact your child's school for exact schedules.**

### KINDERGARTEN - ENGLISH & FRENCH IMMERSION

If your child is five years of age on or before **March 01, 2011**, he or she is eligible to register for **Kindergarten**. Children can attend Kindergarten half-day and Preschool half day. Preschool is a Fee for Service program calculated on attendance days per week. **Kindergarten Orientation Week is August 30, 2010 – September 03, 2010. The first scheduled day for Kindergarten is Tuesday, September 07, 2010. Exact school schedules and times can vary. Contact your child's school for exact schedule.**

### GRADES 1 – 12

If your child is six years of age on or before **March 01, 2011**, he or she is eligible to register in Grade One. The first day of classes (full day) will be **Monday, August 30, 2010**, for Elementary, Middle School and High School students.

### TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

**Elementary** students who live 1.2 kms or more from their designated school;  
**Middle & High School** students who live 2.4 kms or more from their designated school;  
**Redcliff** students will be transported to St. Michael's School, St. Mary's School and McCoy High School; **Dunmore** students will be transported to Mother Teresa School, St. Mary's School and McCoy High School;  
**Transportation** will be provided to eligible students to all specialized programs from all attendance areas.

**Bow Island** students contact Prairie Rose Regional Division No. 8 at 403-527-5516.  
**Students living in Saamis Heights & Vista Heights** – City Transit is providing bus service for students who attend Notre Dame Academy. A city bus will do a loop around that area – one run before school and one run after school. Students living more than 2.4 km from the school are eligible for bussing at no charge but still require a pass which may be picked up from the school office. Students residing less than 2.4 kms from the school may use this service but must pay for a restricted youth pass.
