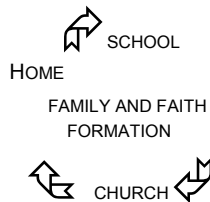

## To All Children and Parents of St. Patrick's Church

**THE SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMS** are for all children (Grade 2 and up) in St. Patrick's Parish and have received the Sacrament of Baptism or Profession of Faith in the Roman Catholic Church.

We ask that you be informed of the following:

1. All children are welcome to participate in the parish sacramental programs, yet only those who are Catholic either by baptism or profession of faith can be recipients of the sacraments on the day of celebration. If your child is not Catholic and you would like to receive the sacraments, please be sure to register for one of our baptism preparation programs. Special arrangements must be made for older children (over six years of age)
2. On the day of registration please bring your child's baptismal certificate and the registration fee of \$20.00
3. It is important that you mark your calendars now for the sacraments of your children so that they will be full participants in the preparation.



### HOME

Parents are the first teachers of their child in the ways of Faith and sharing their own experience of sacraments. It is in the home that children primarily experience and come to really learn about who God is through the loving care of their family.

### SCHOOL

The Medicine Hat Catholic Schools greatly assist in providing the initial preparation for these Sacraments. The religious education curriculum includes a basic and gradually developed teaching of the sacraments,

### CHURCH

The church provides the immediate preparation for all sacraments. Registration, Preparation, and Celebration for First Communion, First Reconciliation and Confirmation programs take place at the parish. Our parish sacramental preparation programs prepare the child for a particular sacrament. This preparation involves both parents and children.
