EARLY LEARNING PROGRAM - ENGLISH & FRENCH PROGRAMMING
Children 3-5 years of age as of September 1 are eligible for Early Learning. Our District provides Early Learning Programming for children with specific learning needs starting at 2 years and 8 months; call Learning Services for details 403.502.8354. Early Learning Programs are a "Fee for Service" program calculated on attendance days per week.

KINDERGARTEN - ENGLISH & FRENCH IMMERSION

Children five years of age on or before March 01, 2019 are eligible for Kindergarten in September 2018. Children can attend a combination of Kindergarten half-day and an Early Learning Program half-day. Exact school schedules and times can vary. Contact your child's school for exact schedule.

GRADE 1 – Children six years of age on or before March 01, 2019, are eligible for Grade 1 in September 2018.

TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS SCHOOLS AND ATTENDANCE ZONES

Elementary students who live 1.2 kms or more from their designated School.

Middle & High School students who live 2.4 kms or more from their designated School.
