

École St. John Paul II School Field Trip Consent and Information Form For Students Grade 1 - 6

At our school, we like to enrich our student's learning experience by going on excursions that will take us off of the school property. In order to do this, we need your permission allowing your child to participate. Below is a list of trips that we **MAY** take and some important information.

Note: Additional information might be communicated by the teacher prior to the field trip.

SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS:

The minimum acceptable standard of supervision for field trips is:

- For students in Early Learning, Kindergarten, one adult to 5 students
- For students in Grades 1 – 3, one adult to 8 students
- For students in Grades 4 – 9, one adult to 10 students
- For students in Grades 10 – 12, one adult to 15 students
- Skiing and Snowboarding trips, one adult to 10 students

Deviation from these standards with permission of the Principal are acceptable for low risk trips based on the following being considered:

- Age of students
- Nature of the activity
- Risk of the activity
- Size of the group
- Participation of special needs students
- Unique or particular circumstances of the venue (crowded, expansive etc)
- Experience of the supervisor(s) relative to the activity
- Other safety concerns
