PARENT / TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Background

The purpose of parent/teacher interviews is to facilitate communication between the school and parents of students enrolled in the school.

The District believes that parent/teacher interviews are an effective way for teachers to communicate student achievement and other information to parents.

Procedures

- 1. Schools will schedule parent/teacher interviews twice per year; once during the first semester (September to January) and once during the second semester (February to June).
- 2. The dates for parent/teacher interviews will be determined by individual schools, stated in the school plan, and communicated to parents and students in the fall of each year.
- 3. Principals, in consultation with staff and School Council, will determine the best time to hold parent/teacher interviews.
- 4. Teachers shall accommodate any reasonable parental request for an interview.
