SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Background

The Division presents a scholarship to a male and female student graduating from Division high schools. The scholarship was initiated to recognize those who helped build our Catholic school system. Today, the scholarship recognizes students who demonstrate spiritual leadership.

The Division believes that spiritual leadership should be encouraged and recognized in our Catholic schools.

Procedures

- 1. A scholarship in the amount of \$250.00 each will be presented to the male and female grade twelve graduating student demonstrating outstanding spiritual leadership at Monsignor McCoy High School.
- 2. The criteria is established as:
 - 2.1 A Religious Studies course must be completed for each year the student is enrolled in the school
 - 2.2 Students graduating with a diploma.
- 3. The Board Chair or designate will present the scholarships at the Awards ceremonies.
- 4. Each scholarship will be awarded only if there is a suitable candidate who meets the criteria.
- 5. Any student wishing to be considered for the scholarship will complete the attached application form. The application form must be submitted to the principal's office no later than June 1.
- 6. A Selection Committee will be convened to review the applications based on the established criteria and select the scholarship recipient. The Selection Committee will consist of the principal or vice-principal, a teacher, the Coordinator of Curriculum/Religious Studies, a trustee and a School Council member.
- The Selection Committee will notify the Secretary-Treasurer in September of the award recipients. The Secretary-Treasurer will be responsible for preparing the cheques to students, and delivering the cheques to the Board Chair or designate prior to the awards ceremony.
