TUITION FEES FOR NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Background

In accordance with the School Act, the Division may authorize tuition fees for nonresident students who are not eligible for Alberta Education funding.

In order to recover the cost of educating students who are not eligible for funding from the Alberta Schools Foundation Fund, the Division may charge tuition fees.

Procedures

- 1. Non-resident foreign students will be required to pay the amount of the average local cost of maintaining the education program in which the student is enrolled, as determined yearly.
- 2. International exchange students may be required to pay the amount of the average local cost of maintaining the education program in which the student is enrolled, as determined yearly.
- 3. Students older than 18 years of age as of September 1 will also be required to pay the amount of the local per student operating cost within the Division, in which the student is enrolled, as determined yearly.
- 4. The Superintendent has the authority to determine tuition waivers for special needs students.
- 5. The Secretary-Treasurer will annually establish the fee to be charged.
- 6. All fees collected by the school shall be submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer.
- 7. The Secretary-Treasurer will credit the fee to the appropriate school-based budget.
