EVALUATION-The Board of Trustees hired Consultant, Dr. Garry Andrews to facilitate the Board's self-evaluation and the evaluation of the Superintendent of Schools. The Board passed two motions: "THAT the Board of Trustees approve the Board's

Self-Evaluation in accordance with Policy 7" and "THAT the Board of Trustees approve the Evaluation for Mr. Joe Colistro, Superintendent of Schools, in accordance with Policy 2". Dr. Andrews was pleased to announce that both evaluations receive high grades. This is a tribute to the Board, Administration, Staff, School Councils and Parent Association in working together to meet the goals of the School Division.

SCHOOL EDUCATION PLANS-During the school year each of our 9 Catholic Schools will present their 2016/17 School Education Plans to the Board. Presentations will focus on the integration of the Division's 7 Strategic Priorities:

ST. JOHN PAUL II-Lots of construction activity on-site in Southridge at our new Catholic Elementary School. FINANCE-The Board approved the use of internal restricted reserves in the amount of \$50,000 for the purchase of the Outdoor Fitness Equipment at Notre Dame Academy; \$16,500 for St. Mary's School for Furniture & Equipment and Teacher FTE and \$11,500 for St. Patrick's School for Learning Assistant FTE.

MONSIGNOR MCCOY Modernization Update

Work continues on the Gymnasium Addition and Reconstruction. All steel work is in place and exterior concrete block walls are in position with steel decking and the roof to follow. With the completion of the enclosure, the



interior work can begin. The concrete floor will be poured in the Gymnasium followed by Ventilation Ducting, Electrical and Lighting Installation, Flooring, Bleachers, Backboards and Divider Curtain. Work continues on the main floor of the North Wing with new Change Rooms, Washrooms, Classrooms and Kinesiology Lab including the installation of the elevator. The next phase will see heavy demolition of the existing Weight Room and transformation of the small gymnasium into additional Student Gathering Space along with a new Ancillary Gymnasium and Exercise Facility. The CTS Shop will be modernized during the last phase of the project. Modernization completion is proposed for the spring of 2017.
