MOTHER TERESA SCHOOL - The Board approved an Infrastructure Maintenance Renewal (IMR) Heating & Ventilation contract for Mother Teresa School in the amount of \$379,625.

JANUARY DIPLOMA EXAMS -Jan 2014 Diploma Exam results were highlighted. The results include marks from both Monsignor McCoy High School & St. Michael's School Bow Island:

- MHCBE students were above the province in 5 of 9 exams in the Acceptable Standard; MHCBE was above (or within 1%) of the **Province** in **5 of 9** exams in the Standard of Excellence;
- Over 33% of MHCBE students achieved the Standard of Excellence in Physics 30; **100%** of **MHCBE** Physics students achieved the Acceptable Standard; 24.0% of MHCBE students received the Standard of Excellence in Social 30-1;
- 100% of MHCBE students achieved the Acceptable Standard in Social 30-1; 100% of MHCBE students achieved the Acceptable Standard on the English Language Arts 30-2 Diploma Exam; 98.9% of MHCBE students achieved the Acceptable Standard on the English Language Arts 30-1 Diploma exam.
