AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT-

▲ pproved – The Audited Financial Statement for 2013 – 2014 was approved by the Board of Trustees. MNP issued a clean opinion on the statements. The Board ended the year with a *surplus* of *\$529,745*.

FALL BUDGET UPDATE Approved – The Fall Budget was approved for 2014 – 2015. There is a forecasted deficit of \$1,057,518. There will be a draw from the reserves of \$783,317 including the transfer of financial assets related to the withdrawal of the Bow Island Ward. CLASS SIZE SURVEY – The Report for 2014 -2015 reflects a slight variable, however, class sizes *remain consistent with provincial targets*: Grades K-3(17); 4-6(23); 7-9(25) and 10-12(27). *Class Size Report* is available at www.mhcbe.ab.ca under Docs & Publications.

WEBSITE RE-DESIGN - The Division website and School websites are under review. We are in the process of doing a re-design resulting in the *overall look* and *accessibility features* changing. The Website Design Committee is now seeking parent consultation and will meet with Parent Association in January 2015. It is important for us to *determine what features of a school website are most important* to parents. New *website designs* are expected to be in place by *mid February* 2015.

INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE PLAN (IMR) Approved - The Board approved the 2014 -2015 IMR Plan: \$547,154 for new projects and \$303,897 for projects in progress from 2013–2014. In the plan there are self-directed IMR funds for schools in the amount of \$3,000 with a top-up available based on eligible floor area to a maximum of \$10,000. Currently, we are developing drawings of what a re-designed parking lot at Mother Teresa School may look like that may allow for off-road parking for vehicles and buses. The government does not provide funds for bus lanes.

BILL 10 – Liberal MLA Laurie Blakeman introduced a private member's **Bill 202** requiring School Boards to support Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) groups in Alberta's Schools. Premier Prentice, then introduced **Bill 10** which would balance the authority of Schools Boards to make decisions related to their operations, but will also provide their students who want to form a GSA with a clear legal recourse to do so. **...In response**, the Alberta Catholic School Trustees' Association has published a letter, available on our website, that reads: (ACSTA) **believes**: in an inclusive approach to education—one in which each person, regardless of background, race, social status or sexual orientation is welcomed, accepted and supported.

(ACSTA) supports: inclusive Catholic school communities and protection of the dignity of each and every person; and, safe and caring and inclusive student groups, open to all students, that demonstrate an understanding and respect for the sanctity of human life and respect for every person. Medicine Hat Catholic Board of Education and our Schools fully support the ACSTA's response. Currently Bill 10 is on hold.
