MODERNIZATION CONSTRUCTION - St. John Paul II construction is progressing well. Monsignor McCoy Modernization continues including demolition of the *Central Gathering Space, Auxillary Gymnasium* and *Exercise Facility* as soon as possible. Anticipated *completion is set for Sept. 2017*.

RE-APPOINTMENT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS – The Board of Trustees passed a motion to *seek Ministerial Approval* to *re-appoint Mr. Joe Colistro, Superintendent of Schools* from *August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2020,* conditional on mutual agreement of the contract of employment. Mr. Colistro's current term as Superintendent of Schools with MHCBE expires July 31, 2018.

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING – The Board re-scheduled the Special Board Meeting from Monday, May 15, 2017 to *Tuesday, June 27, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.* for the purpose of approving the 2017-2018 Budget.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES – The Board approved its Strategic Priorities for 2017-2018 following a strategic planning session held on March 28th with members of Administration, Teachers, Support Staff, and Parents & Trustees. The groups collaborated and shared multiple perspectives in setting the five *Strategic Priorities for 2017-2018*:

- 1. To enhance our Catholic Identity;
- 2. To enhance student learning through actions that reflect the values of inclusive education;
- 3. To develop a Literacy and Numeracy Initiative to ensure every student is successful;
- 4. To develop a vision for the use of technology to support student learning;
- 5. To provide a continuum of support for the mental health and well-being of parents, students and staff.

These Priorities will form the basis of the upcoming Annual Education Report & School Education Plans.

SCHOOL NUTRITION PROGRAM GOES **PROVINCE-WIDE** – Our School Division will be implementing a Nutrition Program as part of Alberta's province-wide School Nutrition Program with funding in the amount of *\$141,000*. Funds are provided to establish or enhance existing nutrition programs and will be targeted for the provision of nutritional meals, including costs associated with ordering, preparation and delivery. The program must be universal to all students in the selected K-6 school and must be one full meal, per day (breakfast or lunch) which aligns with AB Nutrition Guidelines. We plan to engage and potentially involve our High School Culinary Arts Program; implement the use of Grow Towers for producing vegetables and Develop Partnerships with local providers of goods & services & other educational and health institutions in delivering the nutrition program. We will submit our proposal to Alberta Education by May 26, 2017.
