

Growing in Faith; Growing in Christ

The Grade 2 program, and its resource, *Growing in Faith; Growing in Christ,* follows the liturgical year, respecting the different seasons with all the moods and colours found in them. Drawing on various stories from Scripture, children will learn the mood and meaning of all of the Church seasons. Each season has its own theological emphasis, guiding the children through the story of salvation to inform and form them. The Grade 2 program fits within the Church's evangelizing mission that we are all united as one in Jesus Christ, our Lord.

In Grade 2, your child will explore the six tasks of catechesis in an age-appropriate and engaging manner through five units that revolve around the liturgical year with the following themes:

Unit 1: We Belong to God's Family

Unit 2: The Road to Bethlehem

Unit 3: Jesus Guides Us

Unit 4: The Story of Lent and Easter

Unit 5: We Are Blessed in Faith

Religious education is an essential and integral part of the life and culture of a Catholic school. Through religious education, students are invited to develop the knowledge, beliefs, skills, values and attitudes needed to build a relationship with God and community through the person of Jesus Christ.
