## **Growing in Faith; Growing in Christ**

The Grade 4 program, and its resource, *Growing in Faith; Growing in Christ,* follows the liturgical year, respecting the different seasons with



all the moods and colours found in them. Drawing on various stories from Scripture, children will learn the mood and meaning of all of the Church seasons. Each season has its own theological emphasis, guiding the children through the story of salvation. The content of the units informs and forms our students. Using their gifts and witness of faith, teachers evangelize as they hand on the faith. The Grade 4 program fits within the Church's evangelizing mission.

In Grade 4, your child will explore the six tasks of catechesis in an age-appropriate and engaging manner through five units that revolve around the liturgical year with the following themes:

Unit 1: Called to Be One
Unit 2: A New Beginning
Unit 3: The Kingdom of God
Unit 4: New Life in Jesus

Unit 5: Building the Kingdom of God

Religious education is an essential and integral part of the life and culture of a Catholic school. Through religious education, students are invited to develop the knowledge, beliefs, skills, values and attitudes needed to build a relationship with God and community through the person of Jesus Christ. In Catholic schools, students participate in a religious education program that is authorized by the Bishop of the local diocese.

Religious education shares the same goals and objectives set forth for all good education; that is, the growth and development of the whole person in all his or her dimensions—physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual.
