2019-2020 BUDGET ASSUMPTIONS- The Board of Trustees approved the Budget Assumptions for 2019-2020 as amended, the amendment included: "to staff a .5 FTE Academy Coordinator for 2019-2020". Budget Assumptions are detailed in the January 2019 Board Agenda Package on pages 30 & 31.

IMR PLAN AMENDMENTS - The Board approved the installation of a change table at St. Patrick's School and a door assist in the administration office at Monsignor McCoy High School for a total of \$7,200 plus non-refundable GST.

STRATEGIC PLANNING - The Board's upcoming annual Strategic Planning Session scheduled for April 4, 2019 will focus on establishing Board Priorities for next year that will guide the School Ed Plan and the District's 3-Year Ed Plan. Stakeholders will include Trustees, Sr. Admin, School Administrators and Staff & Parents.

GRADUAL RETIREMENT PLAN - Annually, the Board reviews the Gradual Retirement Plan and determines whether or not to continue to offer the plan. At the January 8, 2019 Board Meeting, the Board voted to discontinue the Gradual Retirement Plan.

BROWN BAG LUNCH PROGRAM - Thank you Medicine Hat Catholic Schools' Education Foundation for again funding the delivery of Brown Bag Lunches to students in our Catholic Schools. The funds were received from the Foundation as a **Grant** in the amount of \$3,000! Did You Know?-Brown Bag Lunches are prepared by community volunteers and delivered to students across our City every day. On average, 59-84 brown bag lunches are delivered every day to students in Medicine Hat Catholic Schools. We also extend a thank you to Hillcrest Church and the ongoing volunteers who assemble lunches every day. Recently, students from St. Patrick's School volunteered to make lunches.

CLASS SIZE SURVEY- Annually, the school jurisdiction does an analysis of the student class sizes in our schools and submits a report to AB Education. The detailed report is available on the website, click on: OUR DISTRICT/DOCUMENTS/PLANS & REPORTS. Our class size average: K-3=19.2 / 4-6=20.9 / 7-9=24.6 / 10-12=23.5
