## Catholic School Board approves 3-Year & 10-Year Capital Plan - MARCH 2019 -

The Board of Trustees for the Medicine Hat Catholic Board of Education approve Capital Plans with priorities for three schools,
St. Mary's School, Mother Teresa School & St. Michael's School

The Board of Trustees for the Medicine Hat Catholic Board of Education approved the 3-Year & 10-Year Capital Plan at the March 12, 2019 Catholic School Board Meeting. The top three Capital Plan priorities are detailed as follows:

- 1. Right-sizing and modernization of St. Mary's School Estimated Project cost \$ 12.6 million.
  - Value scoping requested for 2019.
  - a. Facility right-sizing to reduce capacity to 450 students ensuring sustainable operations.
  - b. Facility modernization to enhance Fine Arts facilities for the Fine Arts Academy and facilitate a 21<sup>st</sup> century learning environment for all students; and,
  - c. Address pressing maintenance/replacement requirements for HVAC and electrical systems and upgrade building envelope.
- 2. Right-sizing and modernization of Mother Teresa School Estimated project cost \$ 7.8 million.

Value scoping to be requested for 2020.

- a. Facility right-sizing to reduce capacity to 350 students ensuring sustainable operations and maintenance into the future.
- b. Facility modernization to better facilitate a 21<sup>st</sup> century learning environment for all students;
- c. Address modular classroom that are beyond service life and address pending HVAC and envelope replacement.
- 3. Modernization of St. Michael's School Estimated Project cost \$ 6.4 million.

Value scoping requested for 2021.

- a. Facility modernization to better facilitate a 21<sup>st</sup> century learning environment for all students including open Learning commons;
- b. Address building components including electrical capacity.

As part of the Capital Plan the former St. Louis School, currently leased to CAPE until the end of May 2019 and École St. Thomas d' Aquin were declared surplus to the Board's needs.
