RECRUITEMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS – The Board provided an update regarding the Superintendent of School recruitment process. A motion was passed to *make an offer of employment to candidate #245-001, conditional upon receipt of ministerial approval and mutual agreement of a contract*. Following ministerial approval the Board will issue a media release with the announcement of the Superintendent of Schools. The new *Superintendent of Schools will begin August 1, 2019*.
