- Bachelor of Education is required. Education in early childhood and/or experience will be considered an asset.
- Demonstrated ability to establish collaborative, trusting relationships with early learning team members including early learning program educators, speech language pathologists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, learning assistants, community partners and families.
- Energy and enthusiasm to support children in reaching emotional, social, intellectual, and physical developmental milestones.
- Knowledge and understanding of research-based educational practices to support learning in the early years.
- Strong organizational skills and the ability to work in a fast-paced, team-oriented environment.
- Excellent interpersonal skills with an ability to communicate with school staff, children, parents, and various team members.
