

# Administrative Procedure 492: COVID-19 Vaccination Status



#### Effective December 13, 2021

All adults entering division buildings including, but not limited to: employees, contractors, practicum students, on-site partners, volunteers, parents, guardians and members of the public, as well as contracted bus drivers must provide:



Proof of COVID-19 vaccination OR Proof of a negative COVID-19 test





### I'm vaccinated, what happens when I visit my child's school?

Vaccinated adults will be required to provide their personal vaccine QR code along with a valid piece of photo ID in order to enter any division buildings.

When visitors enter the school building a staff member at the front office will verify their vaccination status by scanning their QR code. When a valid QR code is scanned, a green checkmark will verify the proof of vaccination, and display the person's name and date of birth. The app does not store any personal information.



## How do I get my personal vaccine QR code?

Get your verified COVID-19 vaccine record with a QR code. It's fast and easy — no account required. You will need to know your Alberta Health Care number, date of birth and date of vaccination. Take a screenshot of the QR code for your records.









#### I'm not vaccinated, what are my options?

If not fully vaccinated by December 13, 2021, the adult requesting entry must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 rapid antigen screening test or PCR test completed no more than 72 hours prior to the time they are entering the division building.

# Does this new AP apply to sporting events and extracurricular activities outside of school hours?



Yes. Effective December 13, 2021 all adults entering our school division buildings at any time of day/day of the week must provide proof of vaccination (QR code) OR a valid negative COVID-19 test no more than 72 hours prior to entering the building. This applies to all indoor sporting events, tournaments, concerts etc. in a Medicine Hat Catholic school division building.
