

LETTER OF INTENT – NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING TO HONOR HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II

With September 19, 2022, announced as a National Day of Mourning for federal employees; Alberta declared the day as a Provincial Day of Mourning to honor Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

Subject to agreement by the Employer and the Union, and in accordance with article 18.01: Statutory Holidays, the parties agree that the Provincial Day of Mourning will be added as a single occurrence to the list of general holidays for the 2022-2023 school year. In observance of the federal holiday, employees in temporary, probationary and/or continuing assignments shall receive a day in lieu to be taken when the school is not in operation, provided they meet the requirements of the Alberta Employment Standards Code.
